Refund Rules on cancellation of admission for MBA, MBA HR - Mumbai & PGDM Programme - Navi Mumbai Campus

If a student chooses to withdraw from the program of study in which he / she is enrolled, the institution shall follow the following four-tier system for the refund of fees remitted by the student.

Sr. No.	Percentage of Refund of Aggregate fees*	Point of time when notice of withdrawal of admission is served to the Institute
1	100%	15 days before the formally-notified last date of admission (on or before 4th June 2018)
2	80%	Not more than 15 days after the formally-notified last date of admission (5th June to 5th July 2018)
3	50%	More than 15 days but less than 30 days after formally-notified last date of admission (6th July to 20th July 2018)
4	00%	More than 30 days after formally-notified last date of admission (21st July 2018 onwards)

***(Inclusive of course fees and non-tuition fees but exclusive of caution money and security deposit)**

In case of (1) in the table above, the deduction will be 10% of the aggregate fees as processing charges from the refundable amount. Aggregate fees is inclusive of course fees and non-tuition fees but exclusive of caution money and security deposit.
